For anyone requiring confirmation other than by email please enclose an SAE with your entry. It is your responsibility to ensure you have received your confirmation. Please check and request before the closing date.

Benching

We as a club will provide single pens (2x2x2ft). Two cats from the same household may be penned together in a double pen. **Any requests for penning preferences to be submitted with entry. We will do our best to honor these requests but no guarantee is given.** Exhibitors may provide their own Sturdi Pen or similar with no surcharge for extra space. Exhibitors will bring their own food bowls, litter trays and litter.

Health Requirements

This show is vetted. All cats must have a valid in date vaccination Certificate for Feline Enteritis and Cat Flu. These will be checked prior to entry to the show hall. Any cats where there has been an infectious disease or fungal infection within 21 days of the show date will be ineligible for entry. Claws front and back must be clipped prior to the show. Pregnant and lactating queens will be disqualified.

Show Rules

All TICA show rules will be strictly adhered to. Rosettes will be awarded as per these show rules. Entry means agreement to abide by the decisions of both judges and show committee. Official show rules can be obtained for \$7.00 from TICA, PO Box 2684, Harlingen, TX 78551, USA or from www.tica.org

Official TICA Entry form may be downloaded from the TICA site. Entry fees cover judging, catalogue and one entry pass.

Please note show rule 24.3 entry will be accompanied by the published fee. No entry fee or related charge will be returned except for failure on the part of the sponsoring club to hold the (vetted) show as advertised.

Please note show rule 24.4 Non payment.

Kittens entered must be 4 calendar months but less than 8 calendar months of age on the day of the show. Altered kittens are eligible for entry.

Household Pets over 8 months of age must be spayed or neutered. They are judged in all rings and in order for them to claim titles and regional/international awards they must be registered with TICA.

Transport Cannot be supplied by the club. Nearest airport to accept Pet Passports is Manchester Airport, nearest airport is Humberside, Robin Hood (Doncaster). Mainline trains come into the village of Barnetby. Ferry comes in to Hull (30 minutes away from show hall) from Rotterdam, Amsterdam and Zeebrugge.
